1. James, (b. 1850 IN). He m. Mary Sprinkle, they had Oscar (b. 1873) and perhaps others. They lived in Montgomery Twp., Gibson Co., IN in 1880.
2. Newton, (b. 1854 IN). He m. Cynthia Howe, they had Mary (b. 1880), Newton (b. ?, d. ca. 1991 a suicide), Lincoln (b. ?), and others. In 1880 they lived in Oil Twp, Perry Co., IN.
3. Nancy Virginia, (b. 8/19/1860 IN). She m. Christian Joseph SAALMAN. In 1900 they owned a farm in White Co., IL, immediately adjacent to the farm owned by his sister and brother-in-law George and Hermiena VAUPEL. They had children Mary A. (b. 9/1884), P. Dora (b. 8/1889), Benjamin Franklin (b. 1/13/1892, d. 7/19/1962) and Joseph Victor (b. 11/1898, d. 1956).
